Recent Fundraising Events...



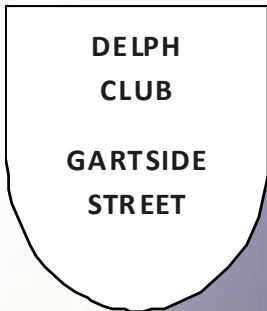
