Dear Parent,

I am writing to you on behalf of the club committee as we need to consider your opinions on an idea that we are looking to start in the New Year.

It is our intention as a club to support 2 different Charities every year, a local charity and a national charity, with the committee selecting the ones to support towards the end of each year in time for our support to commence on the 1st January.

In order to guarantee that we always give something to our nominated charities it is our proposal to you that we donate 1% of the clubs income each year, this means ½ of 1% to the local charity and ½ of 1% to the national charity. In simple terms, of the £144 you all kindly pay each year we intend to donate £1.44 of that to the chosen charities along with 1% of any other income that the club receives. A small amount I know but any contribution to any charity will be gratefully received. There are also other ways the club can support charities and that is by extra fundraising at club events and by helping to create awareness through the use of literature and posters around the workplace etc, there are many ways in which we can help. We feel as a committee that it would be unacceptable to go ahead with this proposal without asking for your approval first as it is your club as much as ours, but we just feel that it is an ethical thing to do and will show people that we are a 'Community Club' as well as a 'Football Club'.

Whilst members of the committee will put forward their own proposals each year for the charity of their choice we would encourage any members who wish to nominate a charity of their own to come forward and put a case to the committee before the final decision is made. The committee will guarantee that all genuine cases will be considered before any announcement is made, so if there is a charity that you are really passionate about and want to support it through the club then please contact us as soon as possible.

In terms of putting things in place to start on Jan 1st we will need to make a decision at the November meeting which will be held on the 15th November at Delph Club as to whether we go ahead with this proposal or we come up with an alternative. If you wish to propose a charity of your own then please let us know before this date. Also, if you strongly oppose what we are proposing then please let us know before the meeting. If you are happy for us to go ahead and act on your behalf then simply do nothing and we will assume that you support our proposal. If you wish to send a message of support then please feel free to do so, the contact details are at the bottom of this letter.

We are hopeful that you will all support this proposal and allow the club to continue with our plan.
